COURSES TAUGHT

Kinesiology: A study of human movement with emphasis on the biomechanics, structure and function of the skeletal, muscular and nervous systems

Evaluation and Measurement: Development, evaluation and administration of statistical tests in exercise science are explored through lecture and practical settings. Basic statistical analyses and their application in interpreting tests and measurements are included.

Upper Extremity Assessment: Recognition and evaluation of orthopedic and athletic injuries; identifying signs, symptoms and mechanisms of injuries; performing special tests for specific orthopedic pathologies related to the upper extremity

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Lower Extremity Assessment: Recognition and evaluation of orthopedic and athletic injuries; identifying signs, symptoms and mechanisms of injuries; performing special tests for specific orthopedic pathologies related to the lower extremity

Athletic Training Administration: This course incorporates the professional administrative and management components of operating an athletic training room. Human resource management, financial resource management, information management, facility design and planning, athletic insurance and legal/ethical practice are topics investigated.

Emergency Cardiac Care and First Aid: Theory and practice for prevention and care of accidents and sudden illness. Covers the requirements for Red Cross Standard First Aid and CPR certification.

Advanced Athletic Training: Survey of the theory and practice of advanced principles and techniques pertaining to prevention and treatment of athletic injuries. Advanced evaluation techniques incorporating movement screens and analysis, special conditions of physically active populations, and evidence based medicine.

Beginning Athletic Training Clinical Proficiency Coursework: A non-classroom experiential course where the student will be introduced to the principles of athletic training and the NATA Educational Competencies in addition to practical aspects of daily athletic training clinic activity.

Intermediate Athletic Training Clinical Proficiency Coursework: A non-classroom experiential course with the NATA Educational Competencies in addition to education and teaching being of a practical nature. This practical course will introduce principles of athletic training and require a significant amount of time to be spent in the practical aspects of daily athletic training clinic.

Advanced Athletic Training Clinical Proficiency Coursework: A non-classroom experiential course with education and teaching being of a practical nature. This practical course will introduce principles of athletic training and require a significant amount of time to be spent with the NATA Educational Competencies in addition to practical aspects of daily athletic training clinic activity on and off campus

Care and Prevention of Athletic Training Injuries: Prevention, examination, and treatment of athletic injuries. Includes methods of taping, bandaging, therapeutic exercises, training room equipment, protective devices and supplies.
